# GUEST HOUSES BED & BREAKFAST HOMESTAY

Guest houses are privately owned homesteads that rent out rooms for a daily rate. The owners often live on the premises and are happy to advise on the amenities and transport available in their local area. Breakfast is normally included in the price, but make sure to always check directly with the individual establishment first. Similarly, bed and breakfasts (B&B's) are small lodging providers that offer overnight accommodation and breakfast.

Always make sure to be vigilant and not disclose your personal information or financial details to strangers unless you have confirmed their identity.
